Nastavna tematska jedinica: Revision of future forms (Future Simple, Present Continuous

and "Going to" future

• Good afternoon, students! How are you today? I hope you are all well and safe.

- Today we are going to revise the future forms we've learnt about in previous lessons. (Danas ćemo ponoviti buduća vremena o kojima smo učili na prethodnim satima.)
- Let's start with Future Simple Tense. We use this tense to talk about predictions, promises, requests, hopes or instant decisions. Form: S+will+ininitive... Example: You will be very rich one day. (prediction) For more examples, open your books on page 143 or your notebooks and find the title FUTURE SIMPLE TENSE. (Počnimo s Future Simple Tensom. Ovo glagolsko vrijeme koristimo kad govorimo o predviđanjima, obećanjima, zahtjevima, nadanjima ili trenutačnim odlukama. Primjer: Bit ćeš jako bogat jednog dana. predviđanje; ovo ne možemo sa sigurnošću reći nikome. Za više primjera, otvorite udžbenik na 143.str. ili svoje bilježnice i pronađite naslov FUTURE SIMPLE TENSE.)
- We use **Present Continuous Tense** to talk about **fixed future arrangements**. Remember what an arrangement means? It means that we have already made some **preparations** for this future activity (and we have **evidence** to support it), such as **bought a ticket for a trip, reserved a restaurant for a wedding party, packed a** suitcase for a holiday etc. Form: S+am/are/is+verb+ing... Example: **She's getting married next month**. For more examples, open your books on page 143 or your notebooks. (Present Continuous koristimo kad govorimo o fiksinm planovima u budućnosti. To znači da smo već poduzeli određene korake u planiranju neke buduće radnje i imamo dokaze koji to potvrđuju, poput kupljene karte za put, rezervacije restorana za svadbu, spakiranog kovčega za odlazak na odmor i sl. Primjer: She's getting married next month. Za više primjera, pogledajte str.143.u vašim udžbenicima ili školske bilježnice.)
- We use "Going to" future when we talk about predictions based on facts and intentions. Form: S+am/are/is+going to+infinitive... Example: We are going to revise future forms today. This is what we INTEND to do. For more examples, open your books on page 143-144 or your notebooks. ("Going to" future koristimo kad govorimo o predviđanjima temeljenim na stvarnim činjenicama ili kad govorimo o namjerama. Primjer: We are going to revise future forms today. Ovo namjeravamo danas učiniti. Za više primjera, otvorite udžbenik na str. 143.-144. ili školske bilježnice.)
